Public invited to ‘Rachel’s Challenge’ presentation at BG High School

Parents and the general public are invited to a presentation offered by the family of Rachel Scott, a high school student who was the first person killed at the Columbine High School (Colorado) mass shootings in April 1999.

The one-hour program begins at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 11, in the cafeteria at Battle Ground High School, 300 W. Main St., in downtown Battle Ground, across from Burgerville.

Rachel Scott’s acts of kindness and compassion, coupled with the contents of her six diaries, have become the foundation for what has been termed “one of the most life-changing school programs in America, Rachel’s Challenge.”

This year’s program, titled “*Rachel’s Legacy*,” will be in conjunction with a school assembly and a six-hour specialized training for 125 students and staff over a two-day period.

The Wednesday evening assembly for the public will include new, specific ways to help reinforce positive student decisions in the community.
