Thieves break in at Pleasant Valley schools

Thieves broke in to Pleasant Valley Middle and Primary schools early Friday morning, doing minor damage and making off with petty cash from small safes they broke into at each school, plus two overhead projectors from the middle school. The schools are at the west end of the Battle Ground School District, 14320 NE 50th Ave.

The break-ins occurred between 2 and 3 a.m. Videos from security cameras showed two men, appearing to be in their 20s.

The Clark County Sheriff's Office has asked to be the source of further information about the incidents. It plans to distribute a press release on the incident later this afternoon via the Flashnet system, according to Sgt. Steve Shea.
