‘Three Musketeers’ opens Feb. 10 for two-weekend run by PHS, BGHS

“The Three Musketeers,” a swashbuckling comedy full of exciting fight scenes, intrigue and romance, will be brought to life on the Prairie High School stage the weekends of Feb. 10-11 and Feb. 17-19 by students from Prairie and Battle Ground high schools.

With a cast of 47 students, the show will be presented at 7 p.m. each night of the run, beginning Thursday, Feb. 10, and Feb. 11, then again the next weekend on Feb. 17, 18 and 19. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for senior citizens and students with ASB cards. They are available online in advance at www.seatyourself.biz/prairiehighschool or at the door. Prairie High School is at 11500 N.E. 117th Ave. Easy access is off N.E. 119th Street just west of 117th Avenue and south of the new Winco food store.

Directed by drama teacher Claire Verity, the play, set in the 17th century, has Sam McPherson in the lead role of D’Artagnan. The three musketeers are played by: Soren Gillaspay, PHS; Anthony Taylor, BGHS; Chris Jastrem, PHS. Constance, the leading female role, is played by Jamie Mackiewicz of PHS.

Director Verity said that in addition to the actors, several students are providing back-stage support in lighting and other roles. Further, she said, “Costumes are the work of amazing parent volunteers, including Terry Maupin, Terri Lejeune and Lisa Henry. The set was designed and constructed by parent volunteers David Ebert and Robert Schultz, with the help of several students.” The show is less than 90 minutes, with no intermission.
