Battle Ground High School Website hacked

Battle Ground Police, with the assistance of school district security personnel and the school district's Technology Services Department, are investigating the hacking on Tuesday of the Battle Ground High School Website.

Unauthorized entry into the site occurred between 2:17 p.m. and 6:17 p.m. Tuesday. The hacker or hackers compromised six different pages on the site with obscenities and vague, general threats, which police have determined were "not credible," according to Principal Tim Lexow.

The site was temporarily shut down while the compromised material was replaced and passwords were changed, Lexow reported.
