Work of BGHS advanced-photography students to be displayed at BG Library

The public is invited to a May 13 reception at the Battle Ground Community Library kicking off a month-long exhibit by 16 Battle Ground High School advanced-photography students.

The public reception is 4 to 6 p.m. Friday, May 13, at the library, 1207 S.E. Eighth Way in Battle Ground Village east off Grace Avenue via Rasmussen Boulevard (360) 687-2322). However, the exhibit, in the library's SWIFT Gallery, opens Tuesday, May 10, and runs through June 10. The library is open Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., and Fridays and Saturdays, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The young photographers are students of Emmy Pellico and Robert Pollock. Their medium is "high dynamic range" photography, which Pollock describes as "an image typically comprising three or more photos of the same scene, taken at different exposures."

The most common HDR photograph, Pollock said, "is made up of a photo taken at normal exposure, a second photo that is under-exposed and a third that is over-exposed." The finished product brings out details that would normally be "blown out" or "be lost in shadow," he said. When the three photos are combined, "you get an image with a high dynamic range."
