### Sheriff's Office investigating exposure near school

Clark County Sheriff's deputies are investigating a Thursday afternoon incident in which a man standing near the road exposed himself to students aboard at least one school bus shortly after it left Tukes Valley Primary School, 20601 N.E. 167<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Petermann Northwest, the school district's contract transportation service, immediately phoned law enforcement. Parents attending an open house at the school Thursday evening were informed of the incident and letters from principals were sent home Friday to parents of students at Tukes Valley Primary and Tukes Valley Middle, which share a campus.

Deputy Scott Gilberti of the Brush Prairie CCSO precinct is investigating.
