PHS dinner-auction set for Hilton Oct. 23

The annual Prairie High School Boosters dinner-auction to support activities and programs from music to sports to classroom equipment at PHS is set for Saturday, Oct. 23, at the Vancouver Hilton.

The price is \$30. But the opportunities to “score” in the silent and oral auctions while helping the school and its students will again make this much more than just an excellent dinner among other high-spirited, civic-minded people.

Here are just a few of the auction items that will be on the block: a three-night stay at Eagle Crest (Ore.) Resort and Spa; five nights in a luxury resort in Costa Rica plus airfare for two; 20 hours of yard labor by the PHS football team; a private wine tasting at a local winery; an “extreme outdoor adventure”, including air fare; a Napa wine country tour; tickets to a pro or college sports event; all kinds of local goods and services, and a variety of themed gift baskets.

Last year, the dinner auction netted almost \$30,000. Proceeds from that and earlier auctions have gone for such uses as a digital reader board in front of the school, a sound system at District Stadium, a sound system for the music department, Junior ROTC uniforms, fire cadet uniforms, sports gear and tournament fees.

The silent auction begins at 5:30 p.m. Dinner is at 6:40, with the oral auction starting at 8 p.m. School Board President Steve Pagel is again the auctioneer.
